Discussion of HSA Purpose/Goals

- The Home School Association is the fundraising body for St. Stephen School.
- Our goal is to raise 10% of the overall school budget \$130,000.
- We want to put the focus on moneymaking fundraisers while also hosting "fun" raisers, which allow the school community to come together to focus on culture.
- We have established sub-committees this year:
 - Sponsorship Coordinator: Kaitlnin Lundberg
 - Room Parent Coordinator: Amanda McMahon
 - Event Coordinator: Kate Burke
 - Volunteer Committee Chair: Jenn Dunning
- As a parent/guardian of a student, you are automatically a part of the HSA.
 - We encourage everyone to get involved to help raise funds for the school.
 - Someone from the HSA board will work with event chairs on the events, so you're not left to figure it out on your own.

Fundraising

- We do not want parents to feel like we are always sending out/pushing fundraisers, so we are looking for ideas that will generate a bigger revenue rather than a bunch of small fundraisers.
- We want to work to target parishioners and the community, so it's not just parents and extended families being asked to donate.

Confirmed

- Welcome Back 5k It was held at Beaver Island this year, which was a great location. The number of 5k runners was up from last year. Waiting on revenue numbers.
- Candy bars We have the potential to make \$10,000 through this fundraiser. It runs the entire school year. Families are encouraged to sell two boxes with each bar \$2/each.
- Shop Fund 716 runs through 9/22. Suggestion not to hold right at the beginning of the school year, as there is so much going on right away.
- Halloween Meat Raffle 10/28 tickets are on sale. We will need several volunteers. A SignUp Genius link will be sent out.
- Shopping Extravaganza 11/11 still have several spots for vendors available. This is an event where we can bring in parishioners and

- community members to support the school. We will be asking for a \$2 entry donation for adults.
- Christmas Card sales We are starting this process earlier this year so we can sell the cards starting in early November. Students are making the cards during art class.
- Family Carnival 2/3/24 The event will mark the end of Catholic Schools Week. We are still looking for event chairs and a committee.
- Fish Fry Runs through Lent. We are looking for a few more co-chairs to work with Kate Burke. The first Friday will return to dine-in, which should help boost revenue.
- April Cash Calendar This was a last-minute success last year and allowed us to target parishioners and community members.
- Walk-a-Thon 5/23/24 Kelly Holland is chairing, and Elizabeth Sharples has volunteered to co-chair. We will need a number of volunteers. This event will be held during school. Students will be tasked with getting sponsors.

- Ideas

- Winter Ball Dance 1/27/24 We are looking to host a dance for 5-8 grades from SSS and other Catholic schools. It would kick off Catholic Schools Week.
 - Lisa Newell and Kristin Gigliotti will chair.
- Online apparel sale Kelly Holland working with Stuarts and online vendors to set something up. Aiming to have it ready so that the apparel arrives in time for Christmas.
- Restaurants Partnering with local restaurants to plan a night where SSS would receive a percentage of sales. Brick Oven?
- Football pools at this time, the Diocese has very strict guidelines on how these can run.
- Chili Cook-off Could this be successful ahead of one of the Sundays ahead of a later game? If so, we would need a chair.
- Mighty Niagara Cards Angela Frommert suggested selling these \$20 cards. They are sold through Niagara Hospice, with half going to hospice and half going to the school.

Sponsorships

- Sponsors have been a huge part of our success for our bigger events. However, we are always targeting the same family businesses.
 - We don't get much support from local businesses that don't have a tie to the school and/or parish.
 - Lisa Newell said her son's hockey team starts looking for sponsors over the summer for their season. We are likely late to the game, doing event by event or waiting until September to start.
