2023-2024 St. Stephen's Ski Club

Dear Families,

The students at St. Stephen's School will have the exciting opportunity to participate in ski and snowboard club at Holiday Valley once again this year. The club will start January 7, 2024 and provides skiing every Sunday for the entire season.

Students can arrive at Holiday Valley by 2:30 and will be provided with a one-hour ski/snowboard lesson each week, which is included in the cost. The lesson is optional for students who are already proficient and have previous experience.

The club is open to all students in grades K-8. *ALL* students will need a chaperone. The Ski club is available for all students and their families whether they are attending SSS or not. Parish is also welcome, but we will not be supplying rides or chaperone coverage at Holiday Valley. This is called a club but it is just for the purpose of getting discounted rates for Holiday Valley. We encourage all parents to share in the chaperoning experience and work together to alternate weeks of coverage to share the chaperoning duties. If there is an emergency, the ski patrol is available to handle all situations. We are on site for serious situations.

Holiday Valley has once again offered us a great deal, with the student club pass (Sunday Ultimate Select Pass) costing \$190, which includes skiing for EVERY Sunday, the entire season. We are only participating January 7— March 3rd , but the students are free to ski any Sunday from season start to finish with friends and family. Even more exciting is that parents are also being offered the student pass price of \$190 for unlimited Sunday skiing. **The passes include an hour's lesson each week as well.**

Unfortunately, transportation is not included, and families are responsible for monitoring and remaining with their children (or a designated chaperone) while at Holiday Valley. NO SUPERVISION IS PROVIDED BY THE SCHOOL, PARISH, OR RESORT. PARENT CHAPERONES ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS.

Lastly, ownership of ski or snowboard equipment is **not** required, as students are offered very reasonable prices for rental gear. Most students and chaperones rent because of the cost of personal gear. The fact that Holiday Valley has Ski and Snowboard gear that is updated every two years and is like NEW and makes the experience that much easier.


