

On Friday, October 27th, food service directors across NYS received information regarding an unexpected nationwide shortage of 1/2 pint milk cartons.

State and Federal guidelines permit schools to serve meals without milk curing the on-going supply issue. Your child's health and well-being remain top priority for the district. Knowing the vital role milk has on our students, the Grand Island food service department will continue to have milk readily available for lunch.

Grades 6-8: 1% white milk and low- fat chocolate milk will be available in bulk for students to self-serve. Students will be asked in the lunch line if they would like a cup for milk and they are welcome to dispense it themselves.

Grades Pre-K-5: 1% and low fat chocolate milk will be available on the cafeteria serving line in pre-portioned cups with lids for Lunch service.

It has been forecasted that the carton issue will last until early January 2024. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Food Service Department.


